<u>Action Requested</u>: RESOLUTION OF THE CHILDREN'S TRUST OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CHILDREN'S TRUST OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020; AND DECLARING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE PROPERTY TAX LEVY AS DEFINED UNDER SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

<u>Budget Impact</u>: The final operating millage rate will result in ad valorem tax revenue of \$138,228,712.00.

WHEREAS, The Children's Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida must adopt a final millage rate in order to raise sufficient revenues for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The Children's Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida held its first public hearing as required by section 200.065, Florida Statutes, on September 9, 2019 and adopted a tentative millage rate of 0.4680 mills for fiscal year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, The Children's Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida held its second duly noticed

public hearing on September 16, 2019 as required by section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Miami-Dade County has been certified by the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser to The Children's Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida as \$310,905,785,149.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE CHILDREN'S TRUST OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

 The final millage rate to be levied in order to produce sufficient ad valorem taxation revenue which will be adequate to pay the appropriations in the budget for the fiscal year 2019-2020 beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 shall be:

Operating millage rate 0.4680 mills

Total millage rate 0.4680 mills

2. The final operating millage rate is 0.4680 which is more than the rolled-back rate of

0.4195 mills by 11.56%. The final operating millage rate of 0.4680 will result in a Resolution 2019-98 – Final Millage Rate September 16, 2019

property tax increase of 11.56% which is more than the roll-back rate of 0.4195 as computed according to the procedures set forth under section 200.065, Florida Statutes, and will produce sufficient ad valorem taxation revenue to pay the appropriations in the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020.

Background:

The operating millage rate approved by The Children's Trust for fiscal year 2018-2019 was 0.4415 mills. The proposed final millage rate for fiscal year 2019-2020 is 0.4680 mills.

Pursuant to section 2-1526 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, The Children's Trust shall prepare a proposed tentative annual written budget on or before July 1 of each year. At its July 2019 board meeting, The Children's Trust unanimously approved a proposed tentative budget of \$165,126,541.00.

Based on this proposed tentative budget, a proposed millage rate must be approved by The Children's Trust and submitted to the Office of the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser within thirty-five days of July 1, along with the date, time and location of the first TRIM hearing. At its July 2019 board meeting, The Children's Trust unanimously approved a proposed millage rate of 0.4680 mills.

At the first TRIM hearing, held on September 9, 2019, management recommended, and the Board adopted, the tentative millage rate of 0.4680 mills. Following the first TRIM hearing, The Children's Trust advertised the proposed final millage rate and the proposed final budget in the Miami Herald newspaper, along with the date, time and location of the second TRIM hearing.

At the second TRIM hearing, on September 16, 2019, The Children's Trust will seek approval of the final millage rate and the final budget for fiscal year 2019-2020, by separate resolutions, each resolution to provide for an effective date.

WHEREAS, The Children's Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the final budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the amount of \$165,126,541.00;

Background:

The final budget has been prepared in accordance with sections 200.065 and 125.901, Florida Statutes, and is necessary to establish the activities of The Children's Trust.

Pursuant to section 2-1526 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, The Children's Trust shall prepare a proposed tentative annual written budget on or before July 1 of each year. At its July 2019 board meeting, The Children's Trust unanimously approved a proposed tentative budget of \$165,126,541.00, representing an 0.48% increase over last year.

At the first TRIM hearing held on September 9, 2019, management recommended a tentative budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 of \$165,126,541.00. The Board adopted the tentative budget, as recommended.

Management proposes a final budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 of \$165,126,541.00. Of that total, 91% is committed to services for children and families in our community through programs and initiatives previously approved for funding by the Board.
