3	DR. BAGNER: And then eventually make a decision
4	by the committee that we would then put forth to the
5	Board. So, I think everyone has I don't know if
б	it's on the screen, but everyone should have or have
7	sent received the timeline. Do we have that up on
8	the board somewhere? Are we able to view that? If
9	not, I can could let you all know I have it in
10	front of me.
11	MR. ALI: Dan, hold on a second. Jim just text
12	me. I think they are not hearing. Hold on.
13	DR. BAGNER: Oh, they're not hearing anything I
14	just said?
15	MR. ALI: Yeah. I think they he said give
16	them a few more minutes. Sorry. This worked so well
17	at programs.
18	DR. BAGNER: That's okay.
19	MR. ALI: The logistics sometimes are
20	challenging.
21	DR. BAGNER: Yeah. But Steve and Susan, you
22	both hear me, right?
23	MR. HOFFMAN: Yeah, I can.
24	DR. BAGNER: Okay.
25	MR. HAJ: Dan, can you hear us?

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1	DR. BAGNER: Yes, now I can. Yes, I can hear
2	you.
3	MR. HAJ: All right, Mr. Chair. We do have
4	quorum.
5	DR. BAGNER: Great. Thank you. Well, we're
6	going to do this again. I just did an introduction
7	just to the people, not in person. So, I'll do that
8	again.
9	Well, welcome everyone. Good afternoon. Thank
10	you for joining us for the Nominating Committee.
11	I'll call this meeting to order. Today, we have a
12	pretty brief agenda.
13	Unfortunately for all of us, Steve Hope, who
14	also is joining our meeting, is terming out of his
15	position as an at-large member for our Board and so
16	we do need to fill that position as a committee, or
17	at least explore applications and make a
18	recommendation to the Board before Steve ends his
19	term.
20	And so, I know that we do have a timeline that I
21	was hoping could be shown on the screen to give us a
22	sense for the timeline for the next over the next
23	few months. There we go.
24	So, assuming we all approve today at our meeting
25	that we can give Jim the go ahead to advertise for

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1	thi	s position that would start tomorrow and then	we
2	wou	ld have the applications for the at-large post	ition
3	due	in February, on February 10th, and then we we	ould
4	rec	onvene as a committee around the 18th.	
5		We'll have to find a time that works for mos	st of
6	us	to review applications with a plan to then	
7	int	erview candidates in the early in early Mar	rch.
8	And	hopefully by the March 15th board meeting, th	nat
9	we	would make a decision and make a recommendation	on to
10	the	Board. Any questions, concerns about our	
11	tim	eline?	
12		MS. LEICHTER: I have a question.	
13		MR. BAGNER: Yes, Marissa.	
14		MS. LEICHTER: It's Marissa.	
15		DR. BAGNER: Hi, Marissa.	
16		MS. LEICHTER: Hi, and you? Are we going to	o be
17		like, even those of us that are here in person	n for
18	the	interviews? Are we going to be able to do the	nat
19	do	you think via Zoom?	
20		DR. BAGNER: Good question. I'll defer to C	Jim
21	and	Imran. I hopefully, we can be able to do	that
22	via	person so we're not putting anyone at a	
23	dis	advantage if they're not comfortable coming in	n
24	per	son. I would certainly prefer that.	
25		MR. HOFFMAN: Hi. This is Ken. My

16	c	one out.	
17		I know it would help me out. I could give m	nore
18	t	time on one day or if we can do it, do it via Zoc	om.
19	F	A more convenient thing for a lot of us.	
20		MR. HOPE: This is Steve. Just a question.	In
21	t	terms of the selection process for the perspectiv	re 🛛
22	k	poard member, is there any particular criteria th	nat
23	Ŵ	ve're looking for in this board member in terms o	of
24	e	any particular background, skill sets, that can m	naybe
25	h	nelp in the deliberation process?

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1		DR. BAGNER: It's a great question, Steve.	That
2	was	actually next on my list once we were all	
3	com	fortable with the timeline, I was going to	
4	hop	efully spend a few minutes talking about what	we
5	wou	ld be looking for in a new member. So, thank	you
6	for	raising that question.	
7		Shanika, are you able do you have a sense	e for
8	the	question on the table?	
9		MS. GRAVES: I'm looking at it now. Just gi	lve
10	me	a few minutes, and I apologize for being late.	. My
11	cal	endar, the meeting was at 3:30 not 3:15, so I	
12	apo	logize.	
13		DR. BAGNER: No worries. It was I think	it
14	was	originally scheduled at 3:30, and then we pus	shed
15	it	up to make sure we had enough time before the	
16	boa	rd meeting.	
17		And what I would recommend while Shanika loo	oks
18	tha	t over, if what Ken said is correct, and the o	only
19	tim	e that we would have to have quorum is in pers	son
20	for	our decision, then I would recommend that we	do
21	exa	ctly what we're doing now for the March meetin	ng,
22	and	we could have a meeting before the March boar	rd
23	mee	ting when people are going to be there anyway,	, and
24	so	we could do that meeting in person, but hopefu	illy
25	we	can interview candidates remotely.	

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1	MS. LEICHTER: Dan, I

3	applications as well.	
4	MS. LEICHTER: I just wanted to say that	at I
5	remember in the past we have done interviews	s even
б	just on the phone.	
7	DR. BAGNER: We did. We did interview	a couple
8	of candidates, you're correct.	
9	MS. LEICHTER: Oh.	
10	DR. BAGNER: Although we were all there	e in
11	person, but the candidate	
12	MS. LEICHTER: Oh, yeah. Okay.	
13	DR. BAGNER: was by phone.	
14	MS. LEICHTER: Oh, yeah. We were in pe	erson, but
15	they were by phone. Okay.	
16	DR. BAGNER: Correct.	
17	MS. LEICHTER: Got it. All right. The	ere was a
18	little bit of a difference.	
19	MR. TROWBRIDGE: Yeah, I think she was	
20	traveling. We did that the last time.	
21	MS. LEICHTER: That's why I think since	e I
22	MR. TROWBRIDGE: She was in Europe.	
23	MS. LEICHTER: I think since I've been	on
24	DR. BAGNER: Correct.	
25	MS. LEICHTER: this committee, over	the years

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1	we've dor	ne it twice to accommodate people.	
2	MS.	GRAVES: Now, Leigh is going to che	eck with
3	one of ou	ar colleagues internally. We're thi	inking no
4	because i	t's a meeting of the committee and	will
5	require f	Eurther committee action, but before	e we say
6	that we w	vant to just get double check wit	ch someone
7	else who	does this type of work and works wi	ith the
8	ethics co	ommission.	
9	DR.	BAGNER: Okay. And you're thinking	g I'm
10	sorry, Sh	nanika. You're thinking no, that's	not a
11	possibili	ty or yes, that is a possibility?	
12	MS.	GRAVES: No, that it's not a possib	oility.
13	DR.	BAGNER: So, we'll wait to hear the	e result
14	on that,	but while we're waiting why don't w	we shift
15	gears a b	oit and talk about what skill set th	ne
16	questions	s that Steve raised?	
17	I wo	ould just maybe start the conversati	ion by
18	saying al	though it's huge shoes to fill, Ste	eve
19	certainly	v has contributed mostly tremendo	ously to
20	our finar	nce committee, chairing that committ	zee.
21	And	so, I think my initial reaction wou	uld be
22	that loop	ing for someone with some experience	ce,
23	expertise	e in finance would certainly be help	pful.
24	I al	so think another consideration befo	ore I open
25	it up wou	ald be around racial diversity. And	d I was

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1	h	oping for the numbers on this and that we could have	
2	t	his hopefully when we meet again to discuss	
3	aj	pplications.	
4		But that to see what our current Board looks	
5	1	ike in terms of racial and ethnic diversity and I	
б	t	hing that should be something that we should also	
7	C	onsider as well. So, I'll open it up to other	
8	t	houghts we can discuss briefly now.	
9		MS. LEICHTER: Dan, I think in the past we have	
10	a	lso looked at all of the board members and the	
11	m	akeup as far as their backgrounds.	
12		Maybe it would be helpful if we just get a list	
13	0	f the board members and see what everybody's	
14	b	ackgrounds are in addition to the diversity issue	
15	t	hat you discussed to get a feel for what gaps there	
16	m	ight be.	
17		DR. BAGNER: Great. Thank you. Yeah, that will	
18	b	e helpful.	
19		MS. LEICHTER: I also just want to remind	
20	e.	veryone that we haven't replaced the we don't	
21	h	ave a physician on the Board. A pediatrician or a	
22	d	octor.	
23		We do have someone whose in administration at a	
24	h	ospital, but we don't have a doctor. We don't have	
25	a	dentist. We don't have anyone whose like an M.D.,	

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1	D.M.D., any	thing in that field and I feel lib	ke the
2	first half	of my time on the Trust, I mean ur	ntil just
3	a few years	ago we always had a physician on	the
4	Board, sinc	e I've been on the Board, which is	s kind of
5	a long time	at this point.	
6	So, th	at might be some sort of maybe we	can when
7	Muriel make	s the advertisement public, if peo	ople have
8	some networ	ks that, you know, kind of flow in	nto those
9	pools. Whe	ther it's at University of Miami t	teaching
10	or, you kno	w, maybe even our board member who	o is at
11	Baptist, mag	ybe he knows of some physician or	
12	pediatricia	ns that would but I think that	is I
13	mean, we ha	ve a great mental health force on	this
14	Board, but	a lot of the children that, you kr	now, we
15	want to ser	ve we also need to it would be	good to
16	have some e	xpertise in part of the physical r	nedical
17	area as wel	1.	
18	So, th	at's something that maybe we can p	put a
19	little fore	thought in and get the application	n in to
20	some of tho	se circles.	
21	DR. BA	GNER: Great. Thank you, Marissa	. Yeah,
22	if we refle	ct back on the last appointments t	that we
23	decided on .	as a committee, the person who's i	in the
24	hospital ad	ministration position has substant	tial
25	finance exp	erience. So, maybe that is not a	parody

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1	at	this point if we feel like as a whole Board, we
2	hav	e enough people and
3		MR. TROWBRIDGE: Yeah, as well.
4		DR. BAGNER: Right. That's right. Any other
5	tho	ughts or ideas on
б		MR. HOPE: Well, I think that, you know, 2020
7	was	a year in which there was a strong cry for
8	inc	lusion and obviously for organizations to have a
9	Boa	rd that was representative of their community.
10		So, you know, I would ask that the Board in its
11	del	iberation at least give some consideration to
12	ano	ther African American on the Board because I
13		When I first joined the Board six years ago, at
14	the	first board meeting, some of you may remember was
15	at	ime when the community was in an uproar because
16	the	y believed that there was limited voice on the
17	Boa	rd.
18		I said it's my hope that we can at least, when
19	mak	ing that deliberation, give some consideration to
20	at	least considering candidates not simply because of
21	the	ir race, but also have the necessary
22	qua	lifications. But it would be helpful if you find
23	som	eone with both. Thanks.
24		DR. BAGNER: Thank you, Steve. Any other
25	tho	ughts?

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1	MR. HAJ: Dan if I may? I just want to let the
2	Board be aware that this I think this timeline
3	works very well for us. We do have six seats that
4	are pending that we hope will be in place before the
5	nominating committee meets on February 18th.
6	We have three gubernatorial seats waiting to be
7	signed off on. Two mayor seats and one commission
8	seat. So, we'll have six more board members so we
9	can look at the entire configuration as we move into
10	filling this position.
11	DR. BAGNER: That will be great. Thank you,
12	Jim. Okay. Well, with that I don't know if we'll
13	get an answer necessarily right now in terms of in
14	person versus virtual, but at the least I'd like to
15	see if we have a motion to approve Jim moving forward
16	with advertising for this position and then at least
17	planning with this timeline that we have proposed.
18	MS. FERRADAZ: I'll make the motion, Ferradaz.
19	DR. BAGNER: Thank you, Gilda.
20	MR. TROWBRIDGE: I'll second it as presented.
21	DR. BAGNER: Thank you, Mark. Any recusals?
22	I'm sorry, any discussion? Okay. All those in
23	favor?
24	ALL: Aye.
25	DR. BAGNER: Opposed? Any recusals? Great.

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1	So	, the motion is approved to allow Jim to move	
2	for	rward to advertise this position and set forth	a
3	tir	meline that we have proposed to us.	
4		MS. LEICHTER: Wait, Daniel. Can you just	put
5	up	the timeline again or can I get it on my thin	adàs
6		MR. TROWBRIDGE: If you swipe.	
7		MS. LEICHTER: If I swipe? There it is. C	kay.
8	So	, just in my brain, we definitely are going to	meet
9	on	February 18th. We'll definitely meet before	the
10	boa	ard meeting on the 15th of March, and then we	might
11	al	l have to meet in person again depending on wh	iat
12	the	e attorneys tell us regarding interviewing,	
13	co	rrect? Just like I'll kind of put these dates	on
14	my	calendar.	
15		MR. ALI: Marissa, the 15th is the board	
16	mee	eting, so we have to you'd have to meet bef	ore
17	the	en. So, the week of March, we just have the w	veek

20		MS. LEICHTER: Wait, I'm sorry. I'm confus	ed.

5		MS. LEICHTER: Correct. That's what I was	s
6		DR. BAGNER: to make our final decision	n,
7	Yeah.		
8		MS. LEICHTER: That's what I understood a	nd
9	that'	s what I was reiterating. Am I incorrect	?
10		DR. BAGNER: That was my that's fine w	ith me
11	unles	s there's any objections to that.	
12		MS. : I just have a question in terms of	the

2		DR. BAGNER: Yeah, I mean I we did like	an
3	init	tial review, I know, before the meeting and	then I
4	bel:	ieve we brought in four or maybe five to	
5	inte	erview.	
6		MS. LEICHTER: Yeah.	
7		DR. BAGNER: I can't remember the exact num	mber,
8	so t	that would be then on that week of March 1st	.
9	Does	s the Monday given that we typically meet	as a
10	Boai	rd on Monday afternoons, would that time worl	k for
11	that	t week of the first?	
12		So, that would be like that Monday the firm	st to
13	have	e the meeting where to have a day, maybe o	or
14	afte	ernoon, where we interview candidates, wheth	er it
15	be :	in person or virtually.	
16		MS. LEICHTER: I'm going to be perfectly	
17	trar	nsparent, I think I will be out of town that	week,
18	so :	if it is I think it's that week. I don't	know.
19	If :	it is not virtual, I might not be able to	
20	part	ticipate. If you do it, let me just	
21		MR. TROWBRIDGE: Right. And if we follow	this
22	meet	ting model, you have to have quorum present.	
23		DR. BAGNER: Right.	
24		MR. TROWBRIDGE: And others can participate	e.
25		DR. BAGNER: Right. And I'll be virtual as	nd

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1	Susan, I	don't know if you'll be virtual. So,	I	
2	think we	would still have enough		
3	MR.	TROWBRIDGE: I think we can make it wo	rk.	
4	DR.	BAGNER: Yeah.		
5	MS.	LEICHTER: No, I will be here. It is	the	
6	week of t	the eighth that I will potentially not	be in	
7	Miami, sc	o I will be able to do interviews and b	е	
8	present t	the week of the first.		
9	MR.	HOPE: And if a quorum is needed, I ca	n	
10	attend in	person if necessary.		
11	DR.	BAGNER: Thank you, Steve.		
12	MS.	KOBRINSKI: So, Mr. Chair?		
13	DR.	BAGNER: Yes.		
14	MS.	KOBRINSKI: Just to confirm. So, the		
15	February	18th meeting, you're going to review t	he	
16	applicati	ons and decide which candidates will b	е	
17	interview	ved, right?		
18	DR.	BAGNER: Correct, correct.		
19	MS.	KOBRINSKI: Okay. And then there's th	е	
20	interview	process and then is there going to be		
21	another m	neeting of the nominating committee to		
22	determine	e who's going to be recommended to the	board?	?
23	DR.	BAGNER: Yes. That will be that we	're	-
24	I'm propo	osing would be on the 15th before the b	oard	
25	meeting.			

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1	MS. KOBRINSKI: Oh, just before the board
2	meeting? Okay. So, I
3	DR. BAGNER: Yeah. So, that one I don't think
4	would be a problem to be to make sure we have a
5	quorum in person, but the question is during the
6	review of applications and then the interview, could
7	those be done completely virtually?
8	MS. KOBRINSKI: Okay. So, we'll have to look
9	into that and get back to you.
10	DR. BAGNER: Okay. And just to I think
11	Marissa might have said this already, but we did
12	interview at least one candidate, perhaps even two
13	last time, they called in.
14	MS. LEICHTER: Right. I think it's a separate
15	question of whether the candidate can be needs to
16	be physically present because they're not a member of
17	the board, so the Sunshine wouldn't apply to them as
18	opposed to you guys.
19	DR. BAGNER: Okay. Well, I would propose that
20	we if that's not the case. If it's a case of the
21	candidates could be virtual, I would propose it
22	regardless of what we do as a Board that we invite
23	them to attend virtually. Are we in agreement? Is
24	there any objection to that?
25	MR. TROWBRIDGE: And your goal is there so that

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1	it's consistent, correct?
2	DR. BAGNER: Correct.
3	MR. TROWBRIDGE: I would agree with that.
4	MS. LEICHTER: Yeah. Since it's fewer people
5	MR. TROWBRIDGE: And it limits our interaction
6	too.
7	MS. LEICHTER: Yeah.
8	DR. BAGNER: Exactly. Okay. Great. Well, any
9	other questions or comments? Steve, I appreciate
10	again you being here and offering your thoughts on
11	this position and I really echo what you said in
12	terms of making sure that we look for someone who's
13	really representing the community.
14	MR. TROWBRIDGE: Could you just clarify for us
15	again, the other positions that are coming up as well
16	because I think that does relate to our ability to
17	look at the entire field in terms of a singular
18	position even though some of that will be slightly
19	our direct control although this one is within our
20	full purpose.
21	MR. HAJ: Well, it is our hope that in the next
22	month or so that we will have the three gubernatorial
23	seats signed off on. We have the mayor, the new
24	mayor has two seats that she should be appointing,
25	and we have one, the commissioner's seat.

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1		So, there's six seats in total that we are	
2	wai	ting for within the next couple of weeks or u	up to
3	a m	onth.	
4		DR. BAGNER: Do we think, Jim, that would b	nappen
5	bef	ore we meet to review candidates by the 18th	of
6	Feb	ruary?	
7		MR. HAJ: Yeah, that's my hope so that you	can
8	hav	e the universe and see all the board members	and
9	the	configuration.	
10		We could bring that diversity in the backg	rounds
11	all	at once, and then we will just have Steve's	
12	pos	ition which will be vacated to consider at th	nat
13	tim	e, and then we'll have all the board seats f	illed.
14		DR. BAGNER: Great. Thank you, Jim.	
15		MS. LEICHTER: I can tell you I'm an incum	pent
16	for	one of those three.	
17		MR. TROWBRIDGE: For the gubernatorial?	
18		MS. LEICHTER: For one of those three I'm a	an
19	inc	umbent. I don't know what the other two are	, but
20	I'v	e been like in a holding pattern for almost a	a year
21	now	. So	
22		MR. TROWBRIDGE: Do we provide that list or	c make
23	rec	ommendations?	
24		DR. BAGNER: It goes to the commission and	the
25	com	mission seat for each seat sends out at le	east

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1	thre	ee names. So, there's Marissa's seat	
2		MS. LEICHTER: For each seat.	
3		DR. BAGNER: and then we have two other	
4	seat	ts.	
5		MS. LEICHTER: Are those incumbents do you	know?
б		DR. BAGNER: Pastor Dunn's one of the	
7	incu	umbents. The other one was Sandy Bore (ph) w	vho
8	vaca	ated, so it's a vacancy.	
9		MS. LEICHTER: Thank you, Jim.	
10		DR. BAGNER: And Jim, can you clarify too f	for us
11	:	I'm thinking in my head someone I know who mi	lght
12	be a	a good fit. The process of board members	
13	ment	tioning the open position to anyone in the	
14	com	munity?	
15		MR. HAJ: Yeah, Mr. Chair, as soon as you -	
16	rigl	ht now, you just gave us the blessing. We'll	l be
17	prep	paring to get it out. We will send it to the	è
18	boar	rd members so you can forward at will to who	think
19	may	be interested.	
20		DR. BAGNER: Okay, great. Thank you. Any	
21	othe	er	
22		MS. LEICHTER: Yeah. Sorry.	
23		DR. BAGNER: Go ahead, Marissa.	
24		MS. LEICHTER: Sorry, I'm talking a lot too	lay.
25	May	be because we've been in hiding for so long.	I

I

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1	would just encourage everyone to send it out to as
2	many, like, groups as they know, as many networks as
3	they have. I think, you know, my God, her name is
4	escaping me. Mary who is your predecessor?
5	MR. TROWBRIDGE: Claudio Brillo (ph).
6	MS. LEICHTER: Claudia. If she taught me
7	anything, she taught me, you know, somethings she's
8	left me with was just, you know, try to get the
9	advertisement as far and wide as we can, so we get as
10	many a diverse pool of applicants as we can. So,
11	if you even if you think it's not people are
12	not interested, just get it out. So
13	MR. HAJ: And Mr. Chair, the advertisements are
14	ready to go into all the different newspapers and
15	radio and the different ad throughout the community.
16	DR. BAGNER: Great. Thank you, Jim. Yes, and I
17	echo Marissa if you folks can pass that and forward
18	that along to people that they would be a good fit or
19	interested in the position.
20	Great. Any other questions, concerns, comments?
21	Okay. With that, we'll adjourn this committee
22	meeting, and I will see all of you in about 15
23	minutes at the board meeting. Thank you all for
24	joining, and I'll see you all next month. Bye-bye.
25	Thank you.
